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Rehearsals are held on Tuesday evenings, Thursday evenings and Sunday afternoons at the St. Peters Cultural Arts Centre. Performance Dates: November 3, 4, 5, & 10, 11, 12(strike). Set Construction occurs on Saturday and Sunday for the two weekends preceding the showing opening date. Tech Week rehearsals occur every day/night from the Saturday prior to opening night through the evening before opening night. A brush-up rehearsal is mandatory on the Thursday(Nov. 9) between the show date weekends. Set Strike occurs immediately after the final performance. **YOU MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL OF THESE DATES TO PARTICIPATE AND BE CAST IN THIS SHOW** with a small number of pre-agreed conflict dates excepted.
